Vineyard Notes

Many critics already regard 2018 as one of Margaret River's best in decades. A higher than average yield meant that some early fruit thinning was required to keep the vines in balance however reliably warm, dry weather through the season provided the luxury of a low risk year. Lacking other pressures, grapes could be hand harvested at their ideal ripeness for the best flavours.

Production Notes

The grapes were handpicked at a variety of ripeness levels over several days. The fruit was hand sorted, crushed and then transferred to fermenters. After the completion of fermentation the wine was pressed off skins and transferred to barrel for 18 months of maturation in 75% new French oak barriques

Honey and oregano slow roasted leg of lamb with all the trimmings
