Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep garnet
Nose: Mulberry, cherry, plum and baking spice.
Palate: Medley of dark red fruits, black cherry, plum and mulberry. Complemented with baking spice, dark chocolate and black pepper and tied together with fine silky tannins giving a long smooth finish.
Cellar: 10+ years

Vineyard. Notes

A cool wet spring paired with great soil health set the tone for a great start to the warm summer. As the weather started to turn, leaf plucking and fruit dropping were instigated, putting us in a strong position for the warm wet conditions to come. Further canopy and fruit management allowed us to pick with optimum ripeness and great fruit intensity

Production Notes

Each grape variety in this blend was handpicked and hand sorted over a period of three weeks to optimise the varietal ripeness before being fermented and matured separately in French oak barrels. After 18 months of oak maturation, the Great Boulder blend is assembled by selecting the finest barrels from different batches to create this unique and intriguing style.

Food Pairing Notes

Venison eye fillet with sweet potato puree and beetroot jus.
